AVSF activities to be implemented in Laos (and Cambodia)

C1: Improving the knowledge on PPA impact and other pig diseases and identification of mitigation measures

Action 1.1.1: Stakeholders analysis and strategies

- Consultancy: field survey to analyze of technical capacities of VVWs, mains constraints to their sustainability and possible ways of improvement
- 2 days workshop at MAF/DLF on the opportunity and perspectives of structuration of the VVWs networks bases on preexisting studies

Action 1.1.2: Analysis of ASF economical impact

➤ 10 days for field survey investigation in villages who suffered from an outbreak to understand the sequence of events, the changes effected and the choices made regarding changes of practices (trade-off)

Action 1.2 Describe the relative importance of pig diseases and analyse the ASF impact to build local response(s) adapted to small and medium scale pig farmers

- Consultancy (20 days): prevalence and incidence survey thourhg participatory epidemiology
- Field survey on KAP regarding ASF as well as biosecurity meaasures and public policies effectiveness at local level.
- Field visits and FGD to "Review, analysis and identification of biosecure farming practices and marketing systems adapted to the different typology of farmers and local constraints as well as the necessary practice changes associated (feeding carcasses management, drug usage, litter management, ...)

C2: Development, diffusion and experimentation of operational tools to control ASF

Action 2.1.2: Communication tools

- Essential biosecurity measures to control ASF (diagnosis, early warning, carcasses managment, biosecured farms and zootechnical practices, marketting and transformation, ...)
- ➤ Good practices in pig farming in general

 Tools adapted to the local stakeholders and adjusted for the different target groups (district veterinarians, CAHWs, villagers, farmersm hunters, ...)

Action 2.1.3: Share innovations and good practices through existing networks and platforms

- > Production of at least 2 communication tools to spread through the networks
- 5 cross visits in Laos and 5 in Cambodia

C 3: Provide a training adapted to the different stakeholders to better control ASF

Provide support and technical expertise to ENSV-FVI- IFIP for:

- training tools directed to small scale farmers
- Training tools for VVWs
- Development and sharing of the pedagogical kit
